



Dozer

Course Objective:

To provide the participant with the skills and knowledge to conduct civil construction dozer operations for a range of mandatory tasks, the fitting, use and removal of attachments and operator maintenance activities.

Relationship to Standards:

- RIIMPO323A – Conduct Civil Construction Dozer Operations

Course Content:

- Plan and prepare for dozer operations
- Operate dozer
- Select, remove and fit attachments
- Relocate the dozer
- Shut down dozer and machine maintenance

Assessment:

- Theory Exam
- Practical Demonstration & Exam
- Assessment to Government credentialing bodies standard is provided at end of course by accredited assessor
- Evidence of onsite experience operating a dozer
- If evidence is not provided within 60 days of successfully passing the written and practical assessment, the assessment MUST be repeated
