### Course Prerequisites:

- Participants must complete a Declaration of Operating Experience for Loadshifting Equipment form from the CITC which must be produced to the Assessor on the day of and prior to the Assessment
- Participants must provide identification and be 18 years of age or over and deemed Competent to be signed off for their National High Risk Work Licence
- Must have basic literacy and numeracy skills
- Drivers licence required if intending to operate on public roads after completion of course
